**2022 HUD SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITY  
TO ADDRESS UNSHELTERED AND RURAL HOMELESSNESS**

**SOLICITATION OF NEW PROJECTS**

**Date of Notice: July 19, 2022**

This Supplemental Continuum of Care Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) is a competitive process, inclusive of CoC planning projects. The maximum award amount for the Wicomico, Somerset, Worcester Counties CoC (unsheltered homelessness projects only) is **\$488,860**.

Somerset County Health Department is the CoC Collaborative Agent and encourages agencies not previously funded through the CoC HUD NOFO to consider applying for funds detailed below.

CoCs may request funding for the following types of projects, all with an initial grant term of 3 years:

1. CoC Planning projects (maximum of 3% of total award, or \$14,665)
2. Permanent Housing projects, including:
  - a. Permanent supportive housing (PH-PSH)
  - b. Permanent housing-rapid rehousing (PH-RRH)
3. Supportive Service Only projects;
4. Joint TH and PH-RRH projects;
5. HMIS

The deadline for project submission is **September 1, 2022**. All projects must be submitted through the e-snaps portal.

Project applicants will be notified by **Friday, October 2, 2022, by close of business** on the acceptance or rejection of their application by the CoC.

The final combined NOFO Application must be submitted in e-snaps by **October 20, 2022**, by the collaborative agent (Somerset County Health Department).
