<p>Vending Machines Updates:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The first data report from the vending machines shows that both machines are being utilized with a total use of 311 times. ● Mostly condoms are being taken however, there are a few Narcan kits that were also taken. ● The machines will be restocked once a week unless the Narcan or test stripes are out then we will go out to restock the machines immediately for those items.
<p>Funding Update</p>	<p>We have \$14,827.00 in purchase of care</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We have \$5,000.00 going to a speaker for Washington High and Crisfield High on November 13th. ● An additional \$5,000 for a speaker for ECI. ● \$2,927 going into the EMS for Somerset Rains Purple. ● Still leaving about \$1900.00 left to spend. <p>We have put \$26,237 aside for Peer salary</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Still have not hired a new peer yet. The next interview is on Wednesday the 30th. ● Due to the late start of the peer we are left with the money to allocate to something else. ● Any suggestions are appreciated.
<p>Cannabis Grant Andra Taylor</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The focus will be on safe storage for edibles, and medical marijuana. ● Underage smoking and driving under the influence. ● We will be working with the evaluator to create the surveys. The evaluator will get the data and the firm will provide a 2 year strategic plan.
